If still having trouble, use this link.

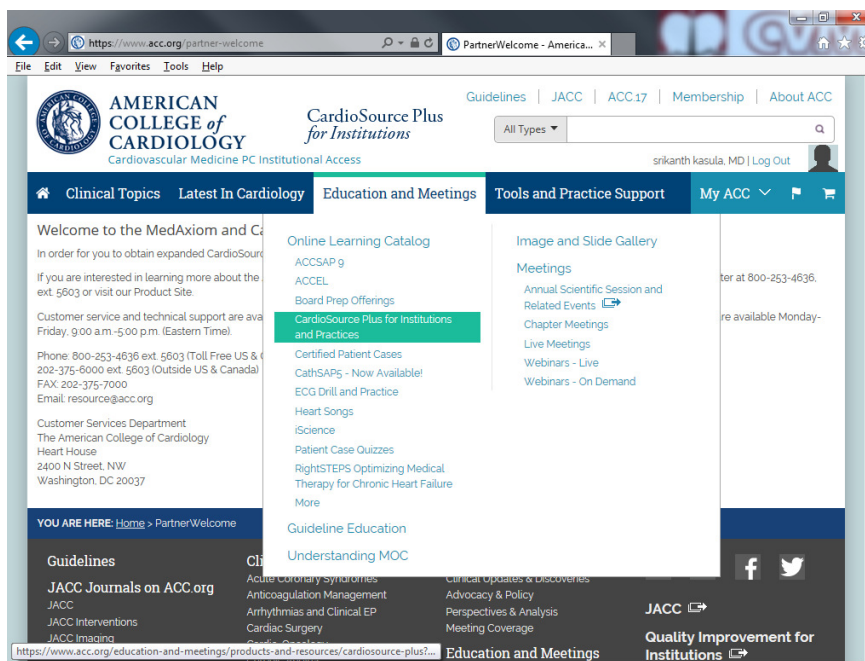

If link takes you to OVID first, log in with cmPCM999 password: welcome1 which should take you to your ACC to log in.

1. Go to acc.org or use the above link and log in to MyACC, near the upper right of the page.



2. On the blue bar click “Education and Meetings” and choose “CardioSource Plus for Institutions and Practices”



3. In the box on the right side of the page choose “CardioSource Plus Subscriber Products” and choose your activity.

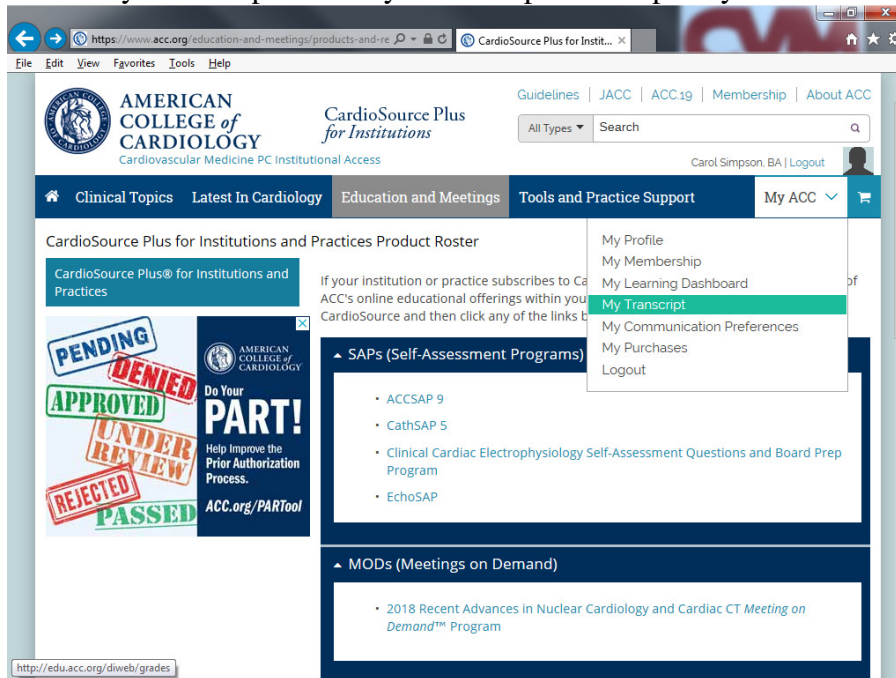

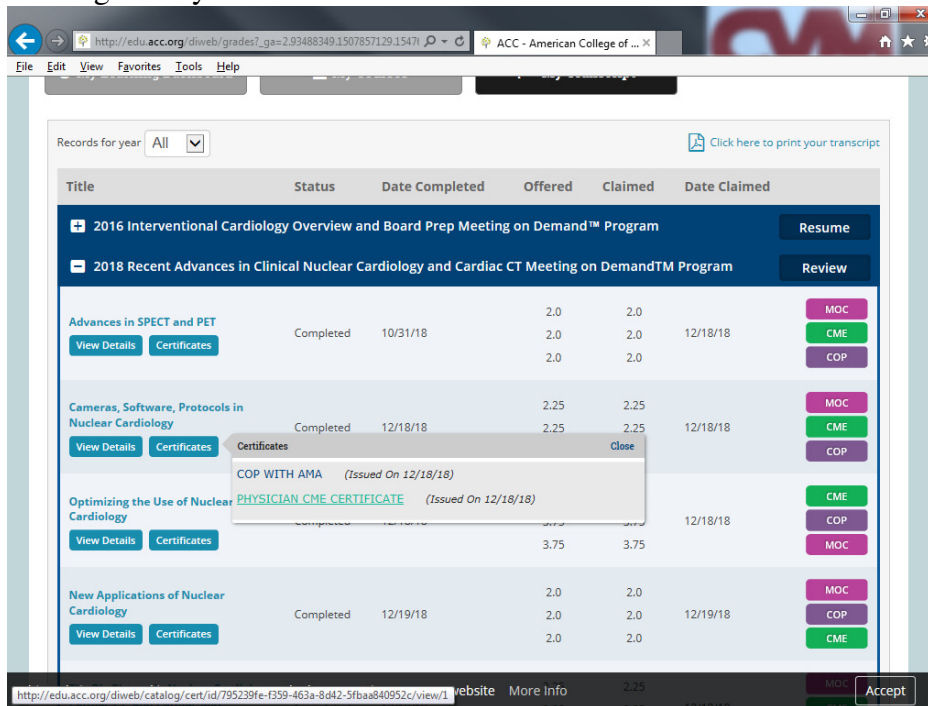
After selecting program, just choose LAUNCH. You should not have to purchase.
